



Diversey Vericlean System

Conducting a Vericlean Audit with 4 easy steps

- Step 1** - Prior to cleaning spray the surface. Use the fluorescent spray 15cm away from the surface. Ensure spray is sufficient and covering the area you will audit.
- Step 2** - The housekeeper/cleaner cleans the room following the normal cleaning procedure.
- Step 3** - The auditor checks the marked surfaces with the UV black light for the removal of the fluorescent spray. If the surface is clean the black light will not show signs of the fluorescent spray. (See A)
If the surface is not properly cleaned the spray will be visible when the light shines as bright spatters. (See below B)
- Step 4** - The auditor adds the information into the audit sheet for review by your facility to track cleaning improvements. If fluorescent is removed click and doc will place a tick. If not removed leave blank.
