Directions for use

Healthcare settings

When used in healthcare settings follow the facility policies and procedures for required concentration (i.e. parts per million [ppm]) for general purpose cleaning, sanitising and/or cleaning and disinfection.

Prepare desired solution according to the table above. Apply diluted Divercleanse solution to surface. Scrub or wipe over surface. Rinse.

Use undiluted to remove mould, stains and odour.

To kill COVID-19 and MRSA, prepare 5000ppm solution (see table above for preparation). Apply to surface, allow 1min contact time. Rinse.

For use as a Hospital Grade Disinfectant, prepare a 1:4 solution (128ml per 750ml of solution). Apply to surface and leave for 10minutes. Rinse.

Hard surface disinfectant only. Not to be used on skin. Not to be used on medical devices or other therapeutic goods.

Store below 25°C.Discard diluted solutions after use.

Not intended to be used on medical devices. Do not mix with detergents or other chemicals. Store below 25°C. Discard diluted solutions after use.

Under recommended conditions of use, Divercleanse is highly versatile and is suitable on most washroom surfaces such as shower recesses, tiles and toilets, as well as drains and waste pipes, refuse receptacles and bins. Divercleanse can also to remove stains from items such as tea and coffee urns and dish cloths. Divercleanse contains chlorine. Always spot test and ensure surface suitability before use. May discolour fabrics and surfaces. Do not use on enamel, laminates or porcelain if cracked or worn.
